# Examination Information for January 26-February 1, 2023

#### **Examination Times**

Morning examinations will begin at **9:00 a.m.** First dismissal time is **10:30 a.m.** All morning exams will be completed by **11:30 a.m.** 

Afternoon examinations will begin at **12:30 p.m.** First dismissal time is **2:00 p.m.** All afternoon exams will be completed by **3:00 p.m.** 

Students who are not scheduled for a final assessment (exam, presentation, etc.) are not required to attend school on that day. If they choose to do so, they are expected to remain in the library or cafeteria to study.

#### **Missed Examinations**

All students are expected to write examinations as scheduled. If a student is absent, the parent or guardian **must phone** the school **BEFORE** the examination is scheduled to be written. The day the student returns to school, he/she **must make arrangements** with the office to write the missed examination(s). Neglecting to do so could result in the student receiving a failing grade in the subject. A **medical certificate** will be required if a student misses a Final Exam.

### **Major Assignment Policy:**

A major project or assignment has a value of 10% or greater and is required for credit. If a major project or assignment required for credit and is not passed in, the subject teacher must contact the parent/guardian on or before

January 13, 2023 and the assignment must be submitted by the end of the day on January 19, 2023. A student may not receive credit for a course if he/she does not complete a major project or assignment.

Please note: regular classes will continue until **Wednesday**, **January 25**<sup>th</sup>.

## **Storm Policy in relation to exams**

If there is a **one-hour delay**, both examinations will still be written on the scheduled day. The lunch hour will be shortened.

Morning exams: 9:30 am -12:00 pm. First dismissal: 11:00 am.

Afternoon exams: 12:30 pm - 3:00 pm. First dismissal: 2:00 pm.

If **school is cancelled** for the day, examinations will be written the following day. This means that the remainder of the exam schedule is moved ahead one day.

**For example:** If school is cancelled on Thursday, January 26<sup>th</sup>, students will write their Thursday exams on Friday, January 27<sup>th</sup>, their Friday exams on Monday, January 30<sup>th</sup> and so on.

# **Electronic Device Policy during Exams**

During an exam, students are strictly prohibited from being in possession of any electronic devices (phones, smartwatches, and earbuds/earphones...).

Students should place their electronics in their locker before going to the exam room.

If a student does not follow these instructions, they will risk receiving a **zero on their exam**.
